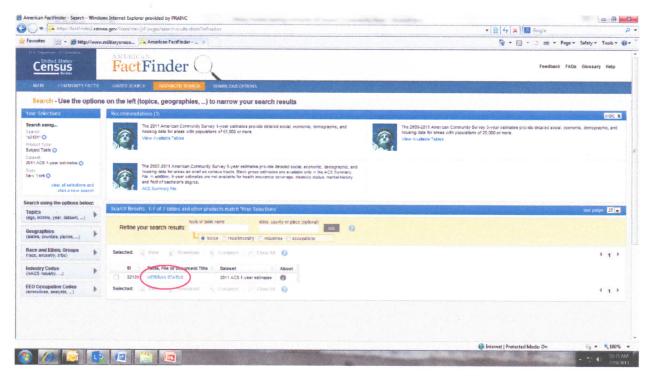

## To Access the date please follow the steps below:

- 1. Access the ACS data set by clicking on the above link: <a href="http://www.census.gov/acs/www/">http://www.census.gov/acs/www/</a>.
- 2. In the Data by Topic section (right column), locate the "Veterans" topic. Click on this topic.
- 3. Click on the Geographies section (left column) in order to add your location.
- 4. Under "select a geography type" choose "State"
- 5. Choose your home state (i.e., "California") and then "Add to your selections"
- 6. Close the geography section (Click on the X at top left).
- 7. Find the link for "Veteran Status" in the middle of the page. Click on this link.



- 8. This should generate a table with the data report for your state.
- 9. At the top right, click "View All As PDF" then save this file on your computer.
